Please read the following information, then check **one of the four** options provided.

- There have been multiple fee proposals to assist with the Pennsylvania State Police budget. One proposal is to charge each municipality \$25 per resident. If this were to pass, the average homeowner's taxes for Youngwood Borough would increase by about \$57-\$65 per year.
As of 5-22-2017, no fee has been agreed to and there might be no fee imposed at all.
- To contract police officers part-time from a local municipality for patrolling and responding to emergency calls in Youngwood, the average homeowner's taxes for Youngwood Borough would increase by about \$110-\$125 per year.
- To form Youngwood's own police force, the average homeowner's taxes for Youngwood Borough would increase by about \$250 per year.
- *Please Note: Pennsylvania State Police will still be responsible for responding to calls in the event that Youngwood contracts officers or forms a new police force.*
