Youngwood Library

Halloween Trick or Treating/Parade

President Palmquist stated he has had some residents voice their concerns about changing the time of Trick or Treat due to the conditions of streets and sidewalks.

Manager Schaefer reported there is a no process for parade permits. They will need to be submitted eight weeks prior to the event and various other items.

Motion by Mrs. Long, seconded by Mrs. Mazurek, to change Trick or Treat for the year 2020 to 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM.
