NOTE: You will still have to drop off or mail-in your payment

- Youngwood Borough will physically hang all Youngwood Veterans banners annually.
- Banners will remain hung between Memorial Day and Veterans Day each year.
- If your banner application is received by the Borough office prior to **Friday, April 26, 2024**, your banner will be hung in time for the 2024 Memorial Day.
- If you are unable to order a banner prior to April 26, 2024, you can still order a banner and it will be hung by the Borough as soon as possible after it is received.
- The Borough will submit orders of (10) or more to avoid the additional cost of printing a smaller order. If you do not want to wait till there is an order of 10 or more, be advised there is a substantial upcharge.
- Banners can be ordered year-round but will only be displayed between Memorial Day and Veterans Day each year.
- Banners will be hung on authorized utility poles along 3rd and 4th Street initially.
- Special placement requests will not be permitted
- You are responsible for replacing your banner if it becomes tattered, torn, or destroyed (by natural or unnatural causes/events).
- You will be notified if your banner becomes unsuitable for public display and have the opportunity to order a replacement (at your cost).
- All banners displayed must be ordered through this program.
- Youngwood Borough is not responsible for your Veteran's banner.
